The <u>Center for Educational Resources</u> is the teaching and learning center supporting instructors in the Krieger School of Arts and Sciences and the Whiting School of Engineering. The CER organizes the <u>Faculty Exchanges</u> program for trainees to observe the teaching methods of award winning instructors on campus!
